



Dougherty County Parks Policy



ROBERT CROSS PARK

Park Hours of Operation:

Park operations are noted below unless otherwise approved by the Director of Public Works.

- Robert Cross Park is opened at dawn in the mornings seven days a week, therefore; the exact time of opening will vary as the season changes. Park patrons are not permitted in the parks before dawn.
- Robert Cross Park is closed at (dusk) dark in the evenings seven days a week; therefore, the exact time of closure will vary as the seasons change. Park patrons are not permitted in the parks after (dusk) dark.

Reservation Availability and Fees:

- Picnic shelters and uncovered tables are available on a first come, first serve basis, unless reserved in advance with paid fee.
- Picnic Shelters are \$40.00 for the day
- Picnic Tables Uncovered are \$10.00 for the day
- Use of the Multipurpose Facility is by Advanced Paid Rental Reservations only.
- Advanced Paid Rental Reservations are on a “first come – first pay” basis and can be made 11 months in advance of the date of the event.
- A \$200 deposit is required at the time of Advanced Paid Rental Reservation and the remaining balance must be paid 30 Calendar days **prior** to the event date. If the remaining balance is not paid **at least** 30 Calendar days **prior** to the event date, the \$200.00 deposit will be forfeited. If the 30th days falls on a holiday or weekend the following business day will be considered the last day for payment.
- No refunds will be issued for events cancelled **less than** 30 calendar days **prior** to the event date. Written cancellations must be received in the Public Works office **at least** 30 calendar days **prior** to the event date to receive a refund. If the written cancellation is received **at least** 30 calendar days **prior** to the event date, then a refund will be issued **minus a \$100.00 administration/reservation fee.** All refunds are subject to the Public Works Director’s approval.

Parks Policy Continued

- Multipurpose Facility rental fees are:

Weekday Rental (Sunday-Thursday 8:00 a.m. till 9:00 p.m.)

\$400.00 per day

Weekend Rental (Friday or Saturday 8:00 a.m. till 10:00 p.m.)

\$400.00 per day

Refundable Cleanup & Damage Deposit, \$200 per event.

Payment Forms: Cash, Cashier's Check, Money Order ****No Personal Checks****

- Fishing at the pond – No Charge. *A current Georgia DNR fishing license is required by state law at public facilities. (No Boats Allowed. No Swimming Permitted).*
- Any events that are advertised to the public require a \$1 million liability insurance policy per occurrence/ \$2 million general aggregate limit general liability insurance policy.

Parks Patrons Responsibility

Park guests must supply all items necessary for their reservation (*tables, chairs, decorations, grills, etc*) with approval by Dougherty County Public Works staff prior to the reserved date.

NO SELLING of any goods or food items within the park including the facility.

NO VEHICLES permitted within the Park (*Examples of vehicles include, but are not limited to: Cars, Trucks, SUVs, Motorcycles, 4-wheelers, golf carts, etc*) All vehicles must be parked in designated Parking Areas. Vehicle access to pavilions must be pre-arranged and approved by the Public Works Director.

All Park Patrons are required to help keep the parks clean and litter free. Anyone who abuses park facilities or equipment may be asked to leave and/or may be subjected to criminal prosecution.

No Alcoholic Beverages Permitted in Park including the Multipurpose Facility
