MOTION FOR GENETIC TESTS

I am the self-represented Petitioner / Respondent / Other interested party [Specify: _____
_____]. My name is: _____. I am filing this Motion for
Genetic Tests. To support this Motion, I present the following facts:

1. Petitioner has filed a Petition for Divorce / Legitimation / Paternity. The paternity of the following
child(ren) named in this Petition needs to be determined:

2. Petitioner Father has submitted his Father’s Affidavit as required by O.C.G.A. § 19-7-43(d).
3. Petitioner / Respondent asks the Court for an Order requiring Petitioner / Respondent / Other interested party [Specify: _____] and the minor child(ren) to undergo genetic tests, including Red Cell Antigen, Human Leukocyte Antigen (HLA), Red Cell Enzyme, Serum Protein Electrophoresis, and Deoxyribonucleic Acid (DNA) tests, in accordance with O.C.G.A. § 19-7-45 to assist in proving or disproving the paternity of the child.
4. Petitioner / Respondent has volunteered to submit himself / herself for genetic testing, but Petitioner / Respondent / Other interested party [Specify: _____] has refused to submit himself / herself and the minor child(ren) to genetic tests voluntarily.
5. As a result of this refusal, we need an *Order for Genetic Tests* so that all parties to this case can be notified about the test results as soon as the test results are available.

WHEREFORE, I ask the Court for the following relief:

- ___ a. That the Court enter an Order requiring the Petitioner / Respondent / Other interested party [Specify: _____] and the child(ren) to submit to genetic tests as soon as possible;
- ___ b. That the Court enter an order requiring that the genetic tests include Red Cell Antigen, Human Leukocyte Antigen (HLA), Red Cell Enzyme, Serum Protein Electrophoresis, and Deoxyribonucleic Acid (DNA) tests, in accordance with O.C.G.A. § 19-7-45;
- ___ c. That the Court enter an Order requiring that the results of the genetic tests be made known to all parties to this action as soon as the results are available;
- ___ d. That the Court grant Petitioner / Respondent / Other interested party [Specify: _____] any further relief as is just and proper.

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ORDER REQUIRING GENETIC TESTS

Petitioner's *Father's Affidavit* and *Motion for Genetic Tests* having been read and considered, and the full record,
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The minor child(ren) listed below shall submit to genetic tests within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

2. The tests shall be performed by:

and shall be administered by a duly qualified licensed practicing physician, duly qualified immunologist, or other qualified person.

3. The genetic tests to be performed on the Petitioner, Respondent, and minor child, shall include Red Cell Antigen, Human Leukocyte Antigen (HLA), Red Cell Enzyme, Serum Protein Electrophoresis, and Deoxyribonucleic Acid (DNA) tests, in accordance with [O.C.G.A. § 19-7-45](#).

4. Petitioner, Respondent Other party _____ is ordered to pay _____ to the laboratory named in paragraph two (2) within fourteen (14) days of the date of this Order.

5. This Order is enforceable by contempt. If the Petitioner, Respondent Other party _____ refuses to submit himself / herself and/or the minor child to genetic testing as ordered, the Court may hold that person in contempt.

6. Nothing in this Order shall be interpreted to constitute a waiver by either party of any claim or defense of any nature in this action. Neither shall this Order be interpreted to represent an admission by either party of any fact or claim in controversy. The results of said genetic tests shall be made known to all parties to this action as soon as the results are available.
