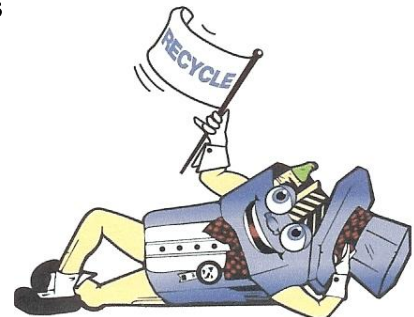

INK CARTRIDGES: FREE... Cartridges will be refilled for reuse

DOCUMENTS: FREE... Shredded by RIVER MILL Data Management

This is the 16th Annual KADB e-recycling event, which has placed 667 tons of electronics into the recycling arena and away from the Dougherty County Landfill.
