February 17, 2024 - Arbor Day Celebration:

A city community Tree Awareness event ceremony

April 19-20, 2024- "Stash-The-Trash" - Community-Wide Litter Awareness Event: Free T-shirts for the first 1,500 volunteers that sign-up. Your team can select their site area...you select the time and location to meet...KADB donates gloves and trash bags.



May 11, 2024 - Document Shredding Event: Collection site: Back Parking Lot of the Albany Civic Center. Volunteers are needed from 8:30 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. A one-day, rain or shine, Private Document Shredding event. Volunteers assist with the unloading of items brought to the Civic Center by citizens.

September 14, 2024 - Go Green Day: Collection site: Back Parking Lot of the Albany Civic Center. Volunteers are needed from 8:30 AM - 1:00 PM. A one-day, rain or shine, Electronic Recycling Collection, Medicine Collection and Private Document Shredding event. Volunteers assist with the unloading of items brought to the Civic Center by citizens.

Date TBA - October 2024 - Rivers Alive: Volunteers are needed from 8:30 AM. - 11:00 AM. Rivers Alive is a state initiative that encourages clean-ups along all 70,150 miles of Georgia's rivers, lakes, and streams. Canoes, kayaks and bank walkers participate in KADB's Flint River clean-up.

Dates TBA - Limb-Up City Crape Myrtles: January, April, July and October
Volunteers meet at a designated location to limb-up crape myrtles.

Organize a group to place Storm Drain Markers on the City Storm Drain Catch Basins. The round 4" metal disk advises citizens that anything placed in the basin flows directly to the Flint River... untreated. Disks are glued down and volunteers will be trained with regard to how much glue to use and where to place the markers on the drain.

Organize a litter pick up event at a time and place you designate. KADB will assist and furnish trash bags.

Adopt-A-Spot: Select a corner of city property; design a beautification plan; get the plan approved by KADB; install improvements (trees, shrubs, flowers); and agree to maintain the enhanced area. A sign is placed with your group's name on it at the site.

Adopt-A-Road: A sign with your group's name on it is placed at the beginning and end of your Adopt-A-Road. Your April pickup should coincide with KADB's Stash-The-Trash event.

Code Ranger: Be trained by the police department to anonymously turn in the citizens that you see littering in our community.
